- Kempsey is part of the Kempsey Shire Council which has a population of 29, 665 people. In 2016 7.1% of the population were born overseas.
- Kempsey is located about 424km north of the Sydney CBD.
- Port Macquarie is part of the Port Macquarie-Hastings Council which has a population of 83, 131 people. In 2016 11.4% of the population were born overseas.
- Port Macquarie is located about 386km north of the Sydney CBD.
